This newsletter was started exactly one year ago in hopes for this day, this moment.

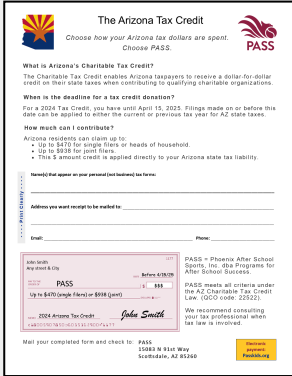
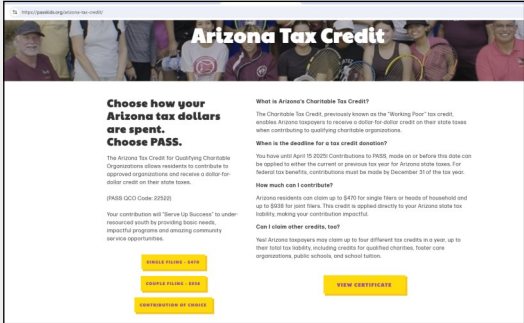

# The Arizona Tax Credit

Choose how your Arizona tax dollars are spent.  
Choose PASS.



## What is Arizona's Charitable Tax Credit?

The Charitable Tax Credit enables Arizona taxpayers to receive a dollar-for-dollar credit on their state taxes when contributing to qualifying charitable organizations.

## When is the deadline for a tax credit donation?

For a 2024 Tax Credit, you have until April 15, 2025. Filings made on or before this date can be applied to either the current or previous tax year for AZ state taxes.

## How much can I contribute?

Arizona residents can claim up to:

- Up to \$470 for single filers or heads of household.
- Up to \$938 for joint filers.
- This \$ amount credit is applied directly to your Arizona state tax liability.
